Online Services

Business Services Online

- Free secure suite of services used to file W-2/W-3 wage reports and to verify Social Security Numbers
- For employers, accountants, and payroll providers
- Different from a my Social Security account
- www.ssa.gov/employer





Registering for Business Services Online

- User provides their personal information; and
- Business or employer's information
- SSA assigns unique User ID
- User creates their own password and selects desired services





Filing Options

W-2/W-2C Online

- Electronic W-2 form; data is directly keyed into SSA system
- 50 W-2s or 25 W-2Cs per report
- Ideal for small businesses
- Businesses can print copies of W-2s for employees on plain paper

Wage File Upload

- Employers upload their electronic report
- Payroll software required to create file for upload





Filing Support Applications

- Social Security Number Verification System (SSNVS)
 - Verify names and Social Security Numbers of hired employees for wage reporting purposes only
 - Not to be confused with E-Verify

AccuWage

- Checks wage reports for formatting errors
- Significantly reduces processing issues
- SSA recommends using this service prior to sending a report

Tips for Filing W-2s Dates and Dollars

- Soc. Sec. Wage Maximum = \$128,400 for 2018
- File with SSA:
 - Electronic by January 31, 2019
 -or-
 - Paper by January 31, 2019
- Do not duplicate e-file by filing paper forms.





Tips for Filing W-2s Name/SSN Mismatches

- 240 million W-2s processed yearly
- Name/SSN matched (97%) = wages posted to employee lifetime earnings records
- Mismatch (3%) = Earnings Suspense File
- Use SSNVS to verify names and numbers before filing





Tips for Filing W-2s No SSN by W-2 Time?

- Electronic Filers
 - Enter all zeroes in W-2 Online or EFW2
- Paper Filers
 - Enter "Applied For" on all copies
- File W-2c after employee receives her/his SSN
 TIP: Use W-2c Online





Tips for Filing W-2s ITIN (from IRS)

- Individual Taxpayer Identification Number 9xx-xx-xxxx
- Non-citizen ID number for income tax filing
- Not valid for U.S. employment
- Not issued if the person is authorized to work in the U.S., but they might have one and later get an SSN
- ITIN are issued from IRS using Form W-7





Tips for Filing W-2s ITIN or "Bad" SSN on W-4?

- Request correct SSN from employee
- If no SSN available by W-2 time
 - Do not change the number to zeroes
 - Enter the number in W-4 "SSN" box on the on W-2 (including E-File)
- File W-2c (electronic preferred) if SSN becomes available later

- Advanced EIC Payment

- If W-2 total is less than 94x total SSA sends notice
- If 941 total is less than W-2 total IRS sends notice





Tips for Filing W-2s Reconciliation - Actions

- Act promptly: Social Security refers unresolved inquiries to IRS for enforcement!
- Complete Social Security's bar-coded questionnaire with your findings and return it to the special PO Box without delay. (Retain copy for your records.)

Tips for Filing W-2s Common W-2 Errors

- Wrong tax year
- Wrong EIN
- Wrong data (e.g., partial/prior year)
- Partial or Duplicate reports
- Name/SSN mismatches
- EFW2 format error or money fields out of balance
- Test file with AccuWage before submitting





Tips for Filing W-2s Filing Corrections (W-2c)

- 250+ W-2c's for most recent closed year requires EFW2C electronic filing, and preferred for under 250 also
- BSO "Create W-2c" Online Fill-In Screens
 - 25 or fewer
 - Prior years within statute of limitations
- Paper Always use latest IRS version
 - Includes State and local boxes
 - IRS Pub. 1223 (substitute specs for forms vendors and software developers)
