

WHEN CAN I RETIRE?

I'm an employee with less than 30 years of service.

*A person attains a given age the day before his or her birthday, and those born on the first or second day of a month are eligible for an annuity beginning date on the first of that month.

**For an employee with less than 10 years of railroad service - If he/she is already entitled to an age-reduced social security benefit, the age reduction applied to his/her tier I will be based on the age reduction applicable on beginning date of his/her social security benefit, even if he/she is already of full retirement age on beginning date of his/her railroad retirement annuity.

NOTE - Employees with any railroad service before August 12, 1983: Tier II reduction remains 20% and full retirement age remains 65 for tier II purposes.
