

RRB Data Governance Body Charter

PURPOSE	<p>The RRB Data Governance Body leads the agency's data governance process of setting and enforcing priorities for managing data as a strategic asset in service of the RRB's mission, including its strategic plan and other high-level priorities. The Data Governance Body establishes a data governance structure with authority over the management of and access to key data assets, including roles for developing, overseeing, and coordinating data management policy and resource allocation.</p>
SCOPE	<p>The Data Governance Body convenes and coordinates agency-wide data governance, which is a shared activity among multiple data stewards and supporting officials. Data governance is foundational to undertaking many activities required by the Evidence Act, and responsibility is shared among multiple parties. The Data Governance Body:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Supports agency priorities, such as those identified in strategic plans and learning agendas, by informing Strategic Information Resources Management Plans for the agency and identifying resources to implement those priorities;• Coordinates and supports implementation of data management responsibilities with agency data-management actors to strengthen strategic plans and learning agendas;• Sets agency data policy in a manner that complements, but does not supplant the statutory authority of established positions; and• Coordinates implementation of the Federal Data Strategy by assessing data maturity, risks, and capabilities to recommend related data investment priorities
MEMBERSHIP	<p>The Data Governance Body, chaired by the Chief Data Officer, membership includes data experts and senior-level staff (or their designees) of each agency bureau/office:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Bureau of Actuary• Bureau of Field Service• Bureau of Fiscal Operations• Bureau of Information Services• Office of Administration• Office of General Council• Office of Programs <p>The members provide coordination and act as the spokesperson for their designated area. Members approach their duties on the body with an agency-wide perspective, having the best interest of the agency's mission and operations in mind.</p>
FREQUENCY OF MEETINGS	<p>Meetings will be held quarterly or more frequently subject to the call of the Chair.</p>
